At St Mary Magdalene Church, Stilton on the 1st of November we hold our Service of Light where we remember those we loved but who are with us no longer. In November we also celebrate

In the midst of remembering I think of the prophet Micah from the Old Testament who presents us with a vision of the future, a future arising from

It points to a future when swords will be turned into ploughshares, and spears into pruning hooks; so that instead of bringing destruction, the weapons of war will be transformed to till the soil.

Micah paints a picture of human flourishing, where lives are lived in harmony and peace. This is the kind of future those we remember hoped, fought and died for. This is the kind of future that, by continuing to remember, we strive to bring about.
